What is a Registered LNR child care provider?

For some people, operating a small daycare is ideal. For others, it can be a stepping-stone to becoming a Licensed Family Child Care Provider.

A Registered LNR child care provider is someone who may care for two unrelated children, in addition to their own (blood, marriage, or foster), OR one sibling group, at any one time.



Becoming registered lets parents know that their child is in a safe environment. The child care provider will have First Aid certification, no criminal record, and have completed a Health and Safety Home Assessment. They will also have some family child care training, and ongoing professional development.

What are the benefits of becoming a Registered LNR?

- Placement on our referral database for parents
- Higher rates of Affordable Child Care Benefit (ACCB) for parents
- Support from our Outreach Consultants
- Access to our Early Childhood Resource Library
- One free workshop per year for professional development
- Free drop-in and networking opportunities

What do you need to become a Registered License-Not-Required child care provider?

You must...

- Be at least 19 years of age (proof of ID required).
- Be a resident of the appropriate CCRR boundary (Delta, Surrey, or White Rock).
- Provide child care for a maximum of two unrelated children, in addition to their own (blood, marriage, or foster), OR one sibling group, at any one time.
- Complete the Child Care Provider Self-Evaluation attached to this package.
- Have one-on-one consultation with a CCRR Outreach Consultant.
- Complete and have clearance of criminal record checks for everyone in the home over 12 years of age (to be done every 5 years).
- Provide at least 2 character references (with one not family related).
- Produce a current valid First Aid Certificate.
- Successfully complete an initial Health & Safety Home Assessment Visit by a CCRR Outreach Consultant.
- Complete a minimum of 20 hours of family child care training (approved by the CCRR).
 *Child care provider must complete this training prior to or within one year of registering as a Registered License-Not-Required child care provider.
- Agree to a minimum of one support visit per year and one Health & Safety Home Assessment Visit.
- Attend at least two professional development workshops per registration year.
- Commit to being the sole supervisor of the child care at all times.
- Ensure registration requirements are completed within one year of process commencing.

Child Care Provider Self-Evaluation LNR Registration Process

The Self-Evaluation form, given out early in the registration process, is an opportunity for you to personally reflect on some of the issues related to the provision of quality child care in your home and is intended for your files only. It does not need to be returned to the CCRR.
